Today, more than forty (40) industries and industrial support businesses call Ennis, Texas their home. Since 1999, these industries have created more than 2,089 new industrial jobs (currently, Ennis industries employ over 4,000 workers). Between 1990 and 2010, the City of Ennis has authorized fifty-two (52) tax abatements to corporations generating an investment of \$636,187,398 in the City of Ennis, Texas.

ENNIS, TEXAS: A REPUTATION FOR PROFESSIONALISM

ASMO Manufacturing, Inc. (ASMO) broke ground on Friday, August 5, 2005 for a 35,000 square-foot manufacturing facility that is located within the Ennis Industrial Park (4601 Sterilite Drive). The ASMO manufacturing facility will ultimately become 500,000 square feet. The new ASMO facility began operations in 2006 and will manufacture automotive windshield washer products for Toyota Motor Manufacturing Texas, Inc. located in San Antonio.

During the groundbreaking ceremony, Greg Alberda, Plant Manager for ASMO Manufacturing, Inc. in Ennis, Texas stated: "We're pleased to be coming to Ennis and believe that the city has a high caliber workforce and is a friendly community. Together these things make Ennis an ideal location for our newest plant." Ennis is located near several current and potential customers. The decision to build a facility in Ennis, Texas is based upon the proximity to these customers and the cooperation and hospitality extended by both state and local governments.
