

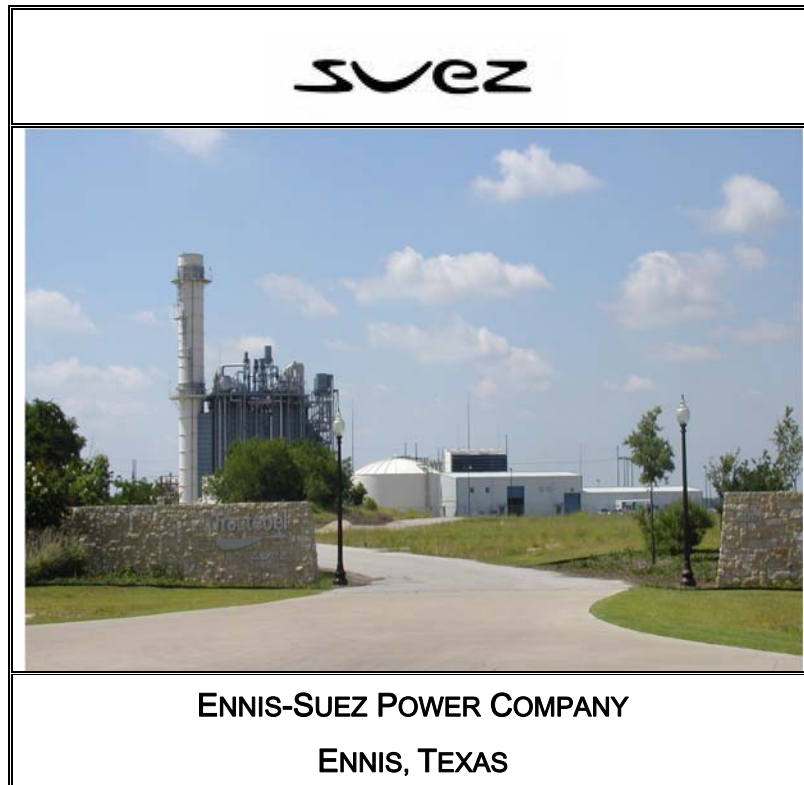

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ENNIS, TEXAS: SUCCESSFUL INDUSTRIAL EXPANSIONS

Today, more than forty (40) industries and industrial support businesses call Ennis, Texas their home. Since 1999, these industries have created more than 2,084 new industrial jobs (currently, Ennis industries employ over 4,000 workers). Between 1990 and 2010, the City of Ennis has authorized fifty-two (52) tax abatements to corporations generating an investment of \$636,187,398 in the City of Ennis, Texas.

The \$200,000,000 Ennis-Suez Power Company is another economic development success story for the City of Ennis, Texas. The Belgium-based-company is using state-of-the-art technology in the operation of its 343-megawatt (net), natural gas-fired, combined cycle, power generating plant. Construction of the Ennis-Suez facility began in February, 2000. The plant became fully operational during the final quarter of 2001.

The economic impact that Ennis-Suez makes upon the local economy is noteworthy. At full capacity, fifteen (15) new jobs have resulted in a significant impact in wages which bolsters the Ennis economy.

Ennis-Suez Power Company rapidly became an important, economical, and reliable source of power for high technology companies that require constant voltage and extremely high-quality power in the vicinity of Ennis. The Ennis-Suez Power Company provides a competitive advantage for Ennis in the recruitment and retention of power sensitive industries well into the 21st century.

Recognizing the advantage of strategic alliances, the City of Ennis has formed effective strategic partnerships with the Texas Economic Development Department (TxED), the North Central Texas Council of Governments (NCTCOG), the Greater Dallas Chamber of Commerce (GDC), Ellis County, the Ennis Economic Development Corporation (EEDC), the Ennis Independent School District (EISD), ONCOR Electric Delivery Company, and the Ennis Chamber of Commerce. These integral affiliations have allowed the City of Ennis to position itself at the forefront of the competition for continued industrial and economic growth well into the new millennium.

The City presently owns approximately 176 acres of fully developed industrial property and is the home to more than 40 industries and industrial support businesses that employ more than 4,000 workers. During the past ten years more than \$506.6 million in capital investment has been made by industries in the city and more than 2,084 new industrial jobs have been created.
